


Need more help setting up...



MAC USERS

1 From your Mac OS X finder, navigate to to the Applications folder, then the Utilities folder. Click **Terminal**.

2 From Terminal, type

```
$ sudo ln -s /System/Library/PrivateFrameworks/Apple80211.framework/Versions/Current/Resources/airport /usr/sbin/airport
```

3 Alternatively, you can type

```
$ cd /usr/sbin  
$ sudo ln -s /System/Library/PrivateFrameworks/Apple80211.framework/Versions/Current/Resources/airport
```

This will prompt you for a root password, enter it and hit return.

4 Turn on your Wifi with this command

```
networksetup -setairportpower airport on
```

5 Next, type

```
$ networksetup -setairportnetwork $INTERFACE "McDonald's FREE WiFi"
```

Where `$INTERFACE` is the "enX" style identifier for your AirPort card (usually en1, but it's en0 on MacBook Airls and en2 on Mac Pros.

6 Finally, confirm your connection thusly. Type `airport -I` at the Terminal prompt, which will return this:

```
$ airport -I  
commQuality: 75  
rawQuality: 59  
avgSignalLevel: -40  
portType: Client  
lastAssocStatus: 1  
SSID: McDonald's FREE WiFi
```


